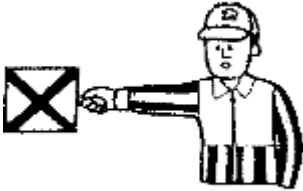
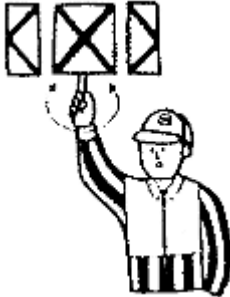
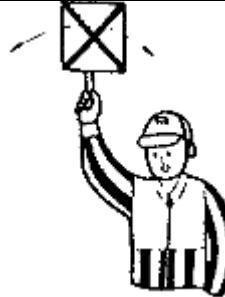
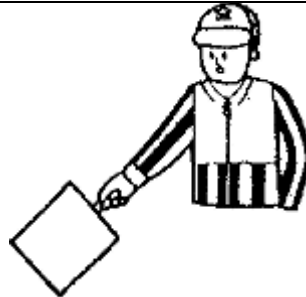
Official hand signals used by the umpire-in-chief.

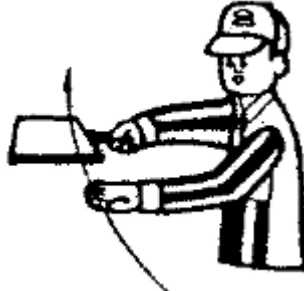

	Offensive player is put out (One hand pointed at the player put out while making the call).		a) Delayed call on catch Used while the runners are still advancing after a made catch. Hand shall be let down before making the whistle call "catch" b) Limited advancing Used when the ball ends in a limited area. The signal shall be stopped when the ball is no longer in the limited area. Used by all umpires if necessary. c) Notice for excessive throwing (delay of game by the pitcher)

	No catch ruled Used on intentional drops and on potential catch plays.		The runner is safe Used when a runner reaches a base legally, especially to rule on a contested base.
5		6	
	Player violation (interference) (Repeated strikes with the side of a hand at the other hand's wrist).		Warning card One-point warning is announced by showing a yellow penalty card.

7		8	
	Time-Out		Delayed ruling Used when spectators interfere with a play, and the umpire-in-chief delays the ruling until the play is over. Runners who advance while the signal is in effect cannot be put out.

	Change of inning (Rotating hands over head level while making the call).

	First bad pitch Plate umpire announces "bad" while showing the signal.		Second and subsequent bad pitches (a walk) Also, a walk on first bad pitch on to empty field. (Rotating the marker over head level). Plate umpire announces "walk" while showing the signal.

	Foul Hit		Catch

	Fair hit		Offensive interference (Showing the cross side toward the umpire-in-chief, striking with the side of free hand at the marker hand's wrist).

	Defensive interference (Showing the white side toward the umpire-in-chief, striking with the side of free hand at the marker hand's wrist).		Wide pitch

	Low pitch		Position violation

	Tangent violation		Out-of-bounds pitch

	Yielding violation		Address by straightening the bent hand towards the clerk and saying "started to withdraw."
